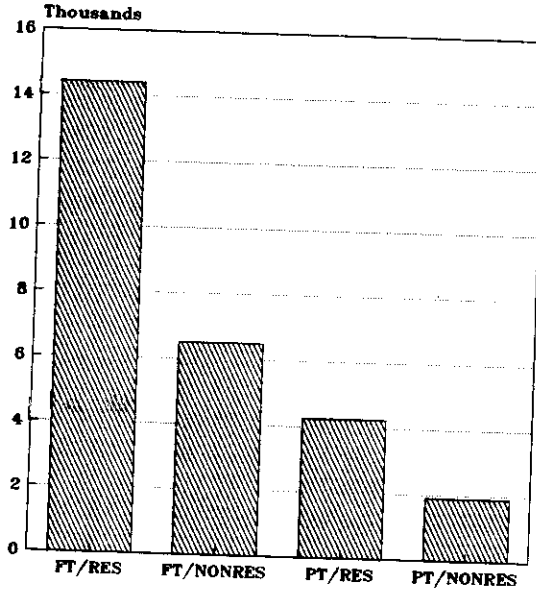

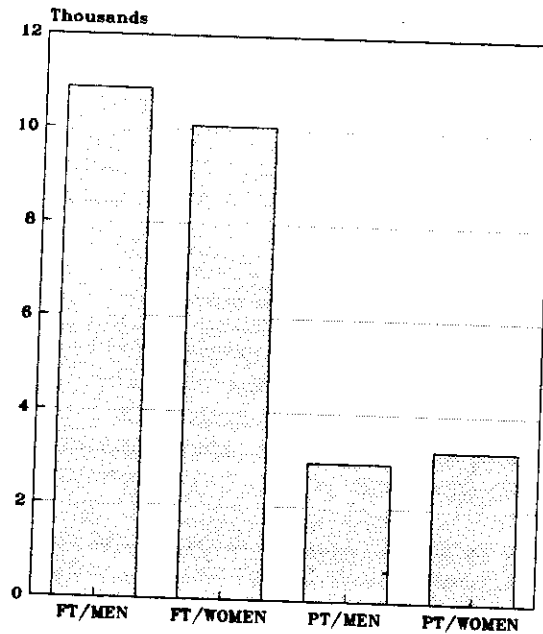

Second Semester 1989-90



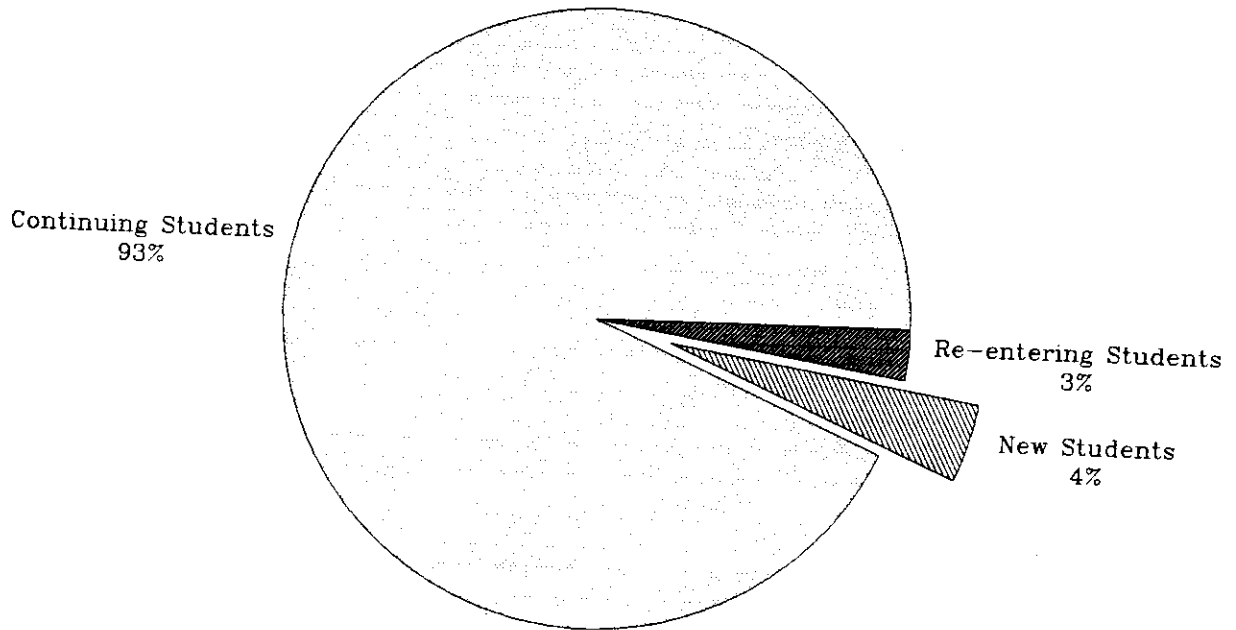

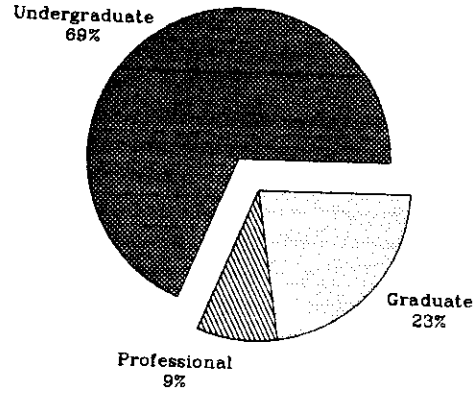
